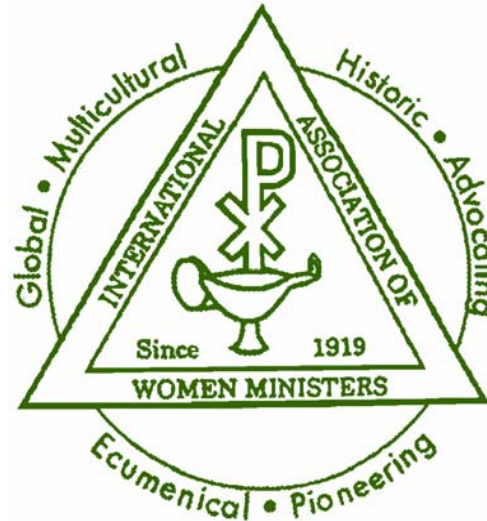

- **Sustaining:** Others who support the purposes and goals of the Association.
- **Life:** Open to all categories
